Maths and English

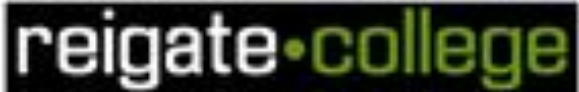


- Those students who do not achieve a Level 4 or above in either English or Maths will be expected to continue with their Maths and English Language study at their chosen college.
