Core Subjects and Pathways (Mon-Thurs)



- English
- Maths (higher/foundation)
- Science (higher/foundation)
 - Split into Pathways for the core subjects dependent on various factors including work ethic, academic ability and resilience.
 - Maths and Science Pathways will be combined.
 - Details of your son's Pathway will be shared in an information letter after Easter.

English



- Pathway 1 will have 3 English lessons and follow the English Language GCSE (or Entry Level). They will also follow the Asdan personal development programme.
- Pathway 2 will have 4 lessons per week and will attempt the English Literature GCSE as well as the English Language GCSE.

Literature

Asdan



This is a life skills programme that draws on skills from a variety of areas which can be used in specific tasks that will benefit the boys now and when they leave Sunnydown.



Maths



- 3 lessons per week for both Pathways.
- Functional Skills in Year 10 and 11.

Science



- Pathway 2 will have 4 lessons per week to prepare for the combined Science Double Award.
- Pathway 1 will also have 4 lessons per week and will follow a modified curriculum which will also allow them to access the Double Award.

Options



- Options have given the boys a choice, not only in terms of subject, but the level of challenge.
- GCSE, BTEC, AQA unit awards, learning experience.
