Dear all who are associated with Sunnydown,

Assembly this afternoon afforded the opportunity of recognising the amazing achievements of Ollie Taylor in Year 10. Within four years at Sunnydown, Ollie has already amassed 1000 House Points. To put this into perspective, this equates to more than 250 House Points per year. Those that have achieved it in the past have done so predominantly in Year 11, at the rate of 200 per year. However, this is so hard to achieve that in some years, no students do achieve 1000 House Points.

Ollie is a perfect example of a young man who is developing his resilience, his independence and cooperation, clearly evidenced by his award today. Huge congratulations to Ollie - the school record is now in his sights!

During assembly I reminded the young men that they had shared their views on some things that they felt were weaknesses. Keeping the young men informed of the work we as a school are doing to help address those issues reminds them that their voice is important and it is heard. I explained my desire and intention to continue to improve Sunnydown on a continual basis. I also acknowledged that some things they have asked for would not be possible - being a co-educational school for example. What we can do however is increase further the opportunities to socialise with girls from other schools. This is an example of compromise.

Regarding listening to the feedback of the SWOT, all staff met on Thursday afternoon and considered the weaknesses identified as part of the process, and the next steps needed to address those weaknesses that we can. We will continue to work through this SWOT analysis, culminating in a plan that steers the school through the ensuing several years.

I appreciate the voice of parents who were able to respond to the SWOT survey and will continue to address the points raised, but also celebrate the strengths.
